

## **What to bring with you...**

### **Essentials**

Usual clothes, toothbrush, pyjamas type things.

Yorkshire in March is COLD! Try and combine layers – the hostel is warm, some of the stops are unheated so can be very cold so it's good to be able to add or remove layers.

Wash kit

Spare bags – for transporting your purchases in. You'll need more of these than you imagine.

Towel - although if you wish to you can rent one from the youth hostel

Cash and cheque book – a number of places don't take cards

Mug – we can borrow cups from the hostel but they are on the smaller side.

Cake - clearly labelled if they contain nuts

Discreet liquor – strictly speaking we should buy it from them but discreet bottles of wine should be fine in the lounge, although not at dinner. Wine and beer is available from reception.

### **Arriving at the Hostel**

Nic will be in reception from midday to allocate rooms and hand out keys. Please remember there is no lunch available on site so please bring your own if you plan to arrive early.

Once you have your key you can go to your room and pick your bed – please be considerate if there are others in your room who can not climb to the top bunk and therefore need the lower bunks.

The rooms do lock but we would advise you not to leave valuables unattended.

There will be a brief welcome chat in the guest lounge at 2.15pm. If you think you will be late please let Nic know.

### **Meals & Drinks**

Breakfast and dinner will be eaten at the hostel. Lunch will be a packed lunch which you collect before leaving each morning. Breakfast – choice of full english, toast or cereal.

Lunch – 1 sandwiches which you will pre-order from a varied list plus fruit, drink, crisps and snack bar.

Dinner – you have already chosen your meals for the weekend.

There will be a vacuum flasks of hot water in, plus tea and coffee supplies in the ballroom all weekend. There is also a full kitchen in the basement which anyone can use.
